

Kerckhaert has produced a new version of the Steel Comfort. The new design has the clips between the second and third nail hole. The heel width for the new Comfort Sport is slightly wider and heels are center punched to allow drilling for studs or tungsten pins.

Shoeing for Winter Conditions

In a recent video posted to Facebook, Mike Wildenstein, CJF FWCF (hons) shows how he sets up a pleasure horse for winter conditions where snow and

ice can be an issue. He used the Kerckhaert polyurethane Snow Rim pad and also inserted tungsten



pins in the heel and toe area. Tungsten pins are easily applied and can often be re-used on resets. You simply drill a hole and tap in the tapered pin. Note that Mike mentions the placement in this case was not centered, but followed the parallel line with the ground on this foot that has a toed in conformation.

JUST A REMINDER



New Baldor Two Speed 1/2hp Grinder

Baldor is now manufacturing a new grinder featuring two speeds. Farriers can run the unit at 1800rpm if they are sharpening knives, or the normal 3600rpm for grinding shoes and other items. This will be a popular choice for farriers who don't have space for both a buffer and grinder in their rig. This grinder has a 5/8" shaft, which is the same as the BG12 unit. The toggle switch shows a fast option, 3600rpm or slow option, 1800rpm. Housing is black to avoid confusion with the 1/2hp and the new 1/4hp buffer that is red.

Kerckhaert Snow Rim Pads

Kerckhaert Snow Rim pads come in both urethane (clear) and rubber (black). The urethane pads are longer-wearing for heavy winter use. Each pair comes in an individually wrapped package.
